Traffic Advisory for Barclays Singapore Open 2011 at Sentosa Island

4 November 2011, Singapore: The Barclays Singapore Open (BSO) will be held at the Sentosa Golf Club from 10 to 13 November.

With limited parking lots available on the island, golf enthusiasts and visitors attending the tournament are advised to take the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) or public buses to HarbourFront MRT Station. From there, they can connect to the Sentosa Express monorail located on Level 3 of VivoCity (next to Food Republic). Next, alight at the Beach Station and board the intra-island bus service (Yellow Line) from the bus bay to get to the event venue. The Island Admission charge of \$3 is applicable per person for the Sentosa Express. Guests can tap and go with their EZ-Link cards. Once on the island, transportation is complimentary around Sentosa.

Alternatively, a special shuttle bus service will be available for the duration of the Barclays Singapore Open. Visitors can board the buses at the HarbourFront Bus Interchange between 6am and 8pm daily. The shuttle service will take BSO ticket holders to and from the tournament grounds at 15-minute intervals.

Visitors who choose to drive are advised to plan their journey to the venue and factor in ample time, in anticipation of the heavy traffic expected during the tournament.
