# Visual Feast of the Arts at Singapore's Biggest Easter Fiesta

The Great Egg-Venture to feature artworks in partnership with Affordable Art Fair; Fun and food galore for the whole family awaits at Sentosa HarbourFront

**SINGAPORE, 17 FEBRUARY 2015** – Singapore's biggest egg hunt is set to return for its third run this year, and promises visitors a unique visual treat. As Singapore moves forward into its next chapter after milestone SG50 celebrations, artists from the *Affordable Art Fair*, students from Temasek Polytechnic and youths from FamChamps will hand-paint 60 giant eggs with designs themed "A New Beginning", translating their vision for Singapore's future into unique public art pieces. These eggs will be part of Sentosa HarbourFront Business Association's (SHBA) *The Great Egg-Venture*, to be held from 10 March to 17 April 2016. This year's event will not only last the longest but also introduce weekly lucky draws, giving participants more chances to win while exploring the precinct.

The Association will also launch a limited edition recipe book featuring the best egg creations from top chefs in the precinct. Guests will also get to sample a selection of these Easter treats at participating hotels and restaurants during the festivities. More than 1 million visitors are expected to visit Sentosa HarbourFront during the event, as the precinct bustles with a galore of activities for family and friends.

Mr Khoo Shao Tze, Chairman of SHBA said, "Easter celebrations at Sentosa HarbourFront has grown in popularity since its inception three years ago, and has made its mark as a signature event on Singapore's tourism calendar. We have enhanced the event experience this year based on feedback and we hope to encourage greater participation and repeat visitations to the precinct."

"Across Sentosa HarbourFront, family-friendly activities and delectable Easter treats will feature among non-stop Easter-themed programming, and visitors can look forward to new offerings and returning crowd favourites. The association will continue to develop our precinct as a year-round leisure and lifestyle destination, with more exciting activities lined up for visitors of all ages," he added.

#### **Giant Egg Hunt**

Singapore's biggest egg hunt, spanning 520 hectares, will take participants through the precinct from atop Mount Faber to Sentosa Island as they hunt for 60 giant eggs, each measuring 1.8m by 1.0m. On top of a Grand Draw, participants can also stand to win attractive prizes every week, including shopping and dining vouchers, hotel stays, attraction tickets and more. In total, more than \$\$50,000 worth of prizes are up for grabs.

The eggs will be hand-painted by local students from Temasek Polytechnic's School of Design, as well as emerging talents to renowned local and regional artists. They include Affordable Art Fair's Young Talent Programme winner Zhang Fuming, renowned local artist Liu Xuan Qi Leo, artists collective Band of Doodlers which will be creating a piece titled "Clear City", Fish Jaafar's "Heirloom of Progress", Iskander Walen who will be co-creating the artwork with his 2-year old son, and many more. Organisations and individuals will also have the option to bring home these works of art by submitting their bids to the Association.

"We are excited to be partnering Sentosa HarbourFront Business Association to extend our public art outreach. This is an excellent platform for our artists to express their hopes and aspirations for the future of Singapore, and engage members of the public in our continuing art conversation. This Easter Fiesta presents an excellent opportunity for families to bond, and we hope to engage visitors through this showcase and encourage greater appreciation of our vibrant arts scene," said Mr Alan Koh, Fair Director at Affordable Art Fair.

The completed works will be on display outside *VivoCity* from 29 February to 6 March 2016, where members of the public can grab photo opportunities with these giant eggs before they are scrambled across the precinct for the hunt.

#### **Everybody Loves Eggs**

Food gourmands can also take a leaf out of a new recipe book to be launched by SHBA. A first in Singapore, this unique *all-eggcompassing* book features 40 egg-based recipes across the precinct. Titled *Everybody Loves Eggs*, dishes featured range from creations at the precinct's celebrity chef restaurants, breakfast dishes with a local twist (*Singapore Kaya Egg Benedict*), to desserts and cocktail. The recipe book will be available for sale across the precinct and at major local bookstores, at a retail price of \$\$18. Each book will also come with discount coupons, which can be redeemed at dining outlets in the precinct.

#### **Easter Fiesta**

Beyond the egg hunt, Sentosa HarbourFront will be abuzz with Easter celebrations, kicking off from 10 March 2016. An *egg-citing* line-up of signature Easter brunches across the precinct's hotels, egg painting and Easter craft workshops will bring something *eggs-traordinary* for everyone in the family.

Throughout the month of March, *Sentosa Merlion Magic Lights* will transform the Merlion Plaza into a spectacular video, light and sound show every evening. On Easter weekend (25-27 March), *Sentosa Egg Fiesta – Garden Edition* will present a myriad of family-friendly activities at the Palawan beachfront, free for all. From 10am – 3pm each day, members of the public can discover a whimsical Easter Garden with colourful giant eggs and bunny characters, while joining in fun activities like egg painting and bunny photo prop making.

Over at Resorts World Sentosa, Universal Studios Singapore welcomes Easter with a new stage show - *An unEGGspected Wedding* — at its Pantages Hollywood Theater followed by a special meet-and-greet with park characters in Easter get-up, and guests can enjoy a scrumptious buffet lunch with Easter characters as well as an exciting park-wide Easter egg hunt. The Easter cheers spread to S.E.A. Aquarium with the return of the underwater Easter Bunny as well as interactive activities for families and children, including a chance to get up-close with Dolphin Island's friendly marine mammals at the *Morning with Dolphins* programme over Easter weekend.
