Sentosa continues Golden Jubilee celebrations by giving back to the Singapore community

- On behalf of the President's Challenge and Community Chest, President Halimah Yacob received \$3,908,888.88 which was raised through the Sentosa Golden Jubilee Charity Golf
- Together with SDC, President Halimah sealed a time capsule containing 50 items that best represent Sentosa Island over the past 50 years

Singapore, 2 September 2022 – Sentosa Development Corporation (SDC) took its Golden Jubilee celebrations up a notch by celebrating with key partners and guests from the public and private sectors at the Sentosa Golden Jubilee Dinner today. The dinner was graced by Guest-of-Honour President Halimah Yacob. Held on the golden shores of Siloso Beach, the Sentosa Golden Jubilee Dinner brought guests on a journey to reflect on and remember Sentosa's transformation to become one of the world's leading leisure destinations today.

As a culmination of its Golden Jubilee efforts to give back to the larger Singapore community, President Halimah, on behalf of the President's Challenge and Community Chest, was presented with a cheque for \$3,908,888.88 by SDC Chairman Bob Tan, witnessed by Minister for Trade and Industry Gan Kim Yong, Minister for Social and Family Development and Second Minister for Health Masagos Zulkifli, SDC Chief Executive Thien Kwee Eng, Community Chest Advisor Phillip Tan, and Community Chest Chairman Chew Sutat. The amount was raised through the Sentosa Golden Jubilee Charity Golf on 27 and 28 August. 100% of the funds raised through the event will be channelled to benefitting agencies of President's Challenge, as well as more than 100 social service agencies and 200 critical programmes supported by Community Chest that help empower the lives of children with special needs and youth-at-risk, adults with disabilities, persons with mental health conditions and seniors and families in need of assistance.

Jointly organised by SDC, Sentosa Golf Club (SGC), and Community Chest and held at SGC, the Charity Golf saw individuals and organisations coming together in support of President's Challenge and Community Chest. Minister for Trade and Industry Gan Kim Yong and Minister for Social and Family Development and Second Minister for Health Masagos Zulkifli hosted the Charity Golf, which was supported by key donors including FTX Foundation, Singapore Exchange Limited, The Barracks Hotel, and Yeo's.

Celebrating 50 years and beyond

To commemorate the momentous milestone, SDC has put together a time capsule comprising artefacts and mementoes from Sentosa's history, which would give future Singaporeans a glimpse into Sentosa's growth over the years.

During the Sentosa Golden Jubilee Dinner, President Halimah placed the symbolic last item into the time capsule and sealed it. Entitled 'Fifty Views on Fifty Years', the commemorative e-book features heart-warming stories and memories from 50 personalities, celebrities, and key stakeholders of Sentosa. Members of the public are invited to re-live the stories in 'Fifty Views on Fifty Years' here.

Some of the other items in the time capsule were:

- Sentosa Heritage Trail booklet Jointly launched with the National Heritage Board, the Sentosa Heritage Trail features 30 heritage sites in Sentosa, including Fort Siloso, which was gazetted as Singapore's 74th National Monument in 2022. The Trail underscores SDC's commitment to remembering and preserving Sentosa's history for future generations. Through the Trail, guests can uncover stories of the communities that once lived on the island as well as former landmarks that have been seamlessly integrated into Sentosa's modern landscape.
- Sentosa Islander membership card The Sentosa Islander membership programme was launched to further enable fans of Sentosa to maximise their Sentosa outings through privileges and exclusive access. The programme was revamped in 2022, and guests can now register for a complimentary membership and start to earn rewards such as discounts at participating businesses on Sentosa, complimentary admission to the island, early access to experiences, and more as they spend on the island. In celebration of the Golden Jubilee,



Sentosa Islanders who are Singapore citizens and Permanent Residents can also enjoy one free cable car ride on the Sentosa Line (valid till 31 October 2022).

• News article on the launch of Sustainable Sentosa strategic roadmap— In 2021, SDC unveiled the Sustainable Sentosa strategic roadmap, in support of the Singapore Green Plan 2023. The roadmap will see the Sentosa community working together to achieve the island's dual goals of achieving carbon neutrality by 2030 and becoming a globally recognised, certified sustainable tourism destination. More recently in August 2022, Sentosa was the first island destination in Asia to be conferred the Global Sustainable Tourism Council — For Destinations (GSTC-D) certificate, affirming SDC's strong push for collective and collaborative whole-of-island efforts towards achieving a more sustainable Sentosa.

Sentosa's Golden Jubilee celebrations continue, with more commemorative experiences lined up in upcoming months.
