Singapore, 1 November 2023 – Prepare to discover an unparalleled symphony of sounds at the first-ever **Sentosa Music Fest 2023** happening from 10 November to 3 January.

Whether you are a jazz aficionado, an electronic dance music (EDM) enthusiast or just a film buff seeking a spirited year-end, Sentosa's inaugural music festival promises an immersive musical journey with distinct happenings and intimate performances reflecting the island's unique personalities at various locales.

This year's festival is an aural celebration featuring unique beach-front events and intimate performances across a spectrum of musical genres. From the electrifying EDM beats at **DJ Spin Off** (25 November) and **ZoukOut 2023** (2-3 December), to a captivating Yuletide musical journey at **Sentosa Christmas** (24 November-3 January), enchanting jazz rhythms at **Jazz by the Cove** (8-17 December), and a high-energy countdown extravaganza at the **Sentosa Countdown Party - presented by Mastercard**[®] on 31 December, Sentosa's stages will showcase a spectrum of talent through a gateway of musical experiences, from hidden local gems to international sensations.

For the less musically inclined, a series of French outdoor cinema screenings, brought to you by vOilah! French Film Festival in collaboration with Sentosa's **Movies by the Beach** will take place on 10-12



November. Guests can also look forward to a line-up of island happenings which are bound to elevate their festival experience.

DJ Spin Off (25 November)

Amidst the rhythmic waves of Sentosa Music Fest, a pulsating current of energy awaits visitors seeking a fun-filled party at Sand Bar, located on Siloso Beach. Immerse yourself in the electrifying beats of DJ Spin Off as the event shapes Siloso Beach into a destination for EDM enthusiasts, while taking the discovery of talents to new heights.

The competition celebrates the future of music by providing a creative space for emerging talents, which will see the judges assess five brilliant budding talents on their technical skills, originality, ability to match beats, and more. The panel itself boasts maestros in the DJ scene – Ollie 'des, Mad Jester, Cherish, and Andrew Chow. The top winner will then secure an opportunity to DJ at the **Sentosa Countdown Party**, while the first and second runners-up will have the chance to DJ at the Sand Bar Countdown Party, giving the winners a platform to showcase their talents.

Jazz by the Cove (8 to 17 December)

Located at the beautiful Sentosa Cove, Jazz by the Cove offers a captivating journey through diverse jazz themes and genres across six themed nights.

From soulful ballads to energetic grooves, each set unfolds like a unique musical tapestry, with unforgettable memories to be created. The opening night features Jazz-Blues Brothers, Jeremy Monteiro and Alberto Marsico, with a powerful representation of the local jazz scene before Malaysian singing sensation Sheila Majid takes the stage to mesmerise the audience with her soulful and jazzy vocals.

The festivities will continue with the harmonious blend of Singapore's jazz aficionados, showcasing Sax in the City and Duncan McKee's Trio with Sinclair and the Jazzkids, followed by the graceful feminine notes of Miss Lou, Alemay Fernandez, and Michelle Poh.

Hailing from Italy, Giacomo Turra takes the spotlight in the following week to enchant with his impeccable grooves before he shares the stage with Soejima Toshiki from Japan. Afterwards, experience the cultural immersion of Japan Jam, featuring Soejimi Toshiki, Shinobu Kawashima (Chili Girl) and Tokyo Groove Jyoshi.

Jazz by the Cove then concludes with an ALL-STARS Jam, where Jeremy Monteiro, Giacomo, Toshiki and Tokyo Groove Jyoshire turns to the stage with the Jazz Association Singapore Orchestra (JASSO), ensuring an unforgettable musical experience for all.
